Graduate Assistant Athletic Trainer

The University of Connecticut Department of Kinesiology is searching for multiple athletic trainers interested in obtaining a Master's of Science or Doctor of Philosophy in Kinesiology. This open position has a start date of August 2025. This is a 100% graduate assistant position and would be a combination of research at the Korey Stringer Institute and working as an athletic trainer at nearby high school. The position comes with full waiver of in-state and out-of-state tuition, medical and dental benefits, and a stipend of approximately \$28,000. There is an opportunity to earn an additional \$10,000 for summer research for those who are in the PhD program. The doctoral program is a four-year, dissertation required plan of study. The master's program is a two-year program with a thesis required.
